Erwin Doll, born on January 12, 1959 in Rheinbrohl in the German state Rheinland-Pfalz, received a graduate degree in mechanical engineering from the University of Kaiserslautern with a specialty in theoretical mechanical engineering. Starting in 1984, he subsequently worked for a total of 13 years at BASF in the plastics division, advancing from project engineer to key account manager and finally sales director. In 1998, Doll joined the automotive supplier Johnson Controls. There, he initially served as sales director and later became general manager of the BMW group business unit. After four years, Doll joined the Plastic Omnium group, where he assumed duties as managing director of German operations. In addition, as a member of the divisional management of Plastic Omnium Auto Exterior he held the position of chairman for the Central European region with responsibility for plants in Germany, Belgium, Poland, and Slovakia. In 2006, Doll joined the Röchling Group, where he was appointed Executive Vice President of Sales and R&D. In 2011, he was appointed spokesperson of the Executive Board.
