



### **Horst-Ulrich Mauß**

Horst-Ulrich Mauß, born on February 23, 1957 in Ellwangen an der Jagst in Baden-Württemberg, Germany, completed two years of service with the German Army in 1979 with the rank of Midshipman of the Reserve. Subsequently, in 1983 Mauß graduated as an industrial engineer with a graduate degree from the University of Applied Sciences in Aalen. During his studies, he also passed a trade exam as a toolmaker. In the same year, he was promoted to Lieutenant of the Reserve. Mauß began his career as plant manager for plastics processing at the company Lapp in Stuttgart, Germany. In 1987, he moved to Elastogran GmbH in Worms, Germany, as plant manager.

Mauß joined the former Seeber group with the acquisition of the BASF Elastogran plant by Röchling in 1992. There, he first worked as plant manager of Seeber Kunststofftechnik Worms KG before becoming Technical Director of Seeber Systemtechnik KG, Worms, in 1993. In September 2005, in addition to his directorship responsibilities, he was appointed to the Executive Board of Röchling Automotive group. Mauß is responsible for the Europe North and America North regions.
