Yuen Kwang Wong, born on September 14, 1958 in Singapore, studied at the Hessen State University in Kassel with a scholarship sponsored by the government of Singapore and Carl-Duisberg Gesellschaft e.V. Germany, earning a graduate degree in civil engineering. At the University of Braunschweig he then completed a postgraduate program in management for engineers. Wong began his career in 1985 as the senior industry officer at the Economic Development Board (EDB) in Singapore. In 1990, Wong was appointed Managing Director of Röchling Engineering Plastics, Singapore. In addition, since 2002 he has been Managing Director of Röchling International (Shanghai). From 2002 to 2007, Wong was a member of the board at Leripa Papertech in Kunshan, China. Wong has served on the Supervisory Board of Röchling Automotive Parts Changchun and Röchling Automotive Parts Suzhou since 2005. In the same year, he also became Managing Director of Suzhou Blue Star Engineering Plastics.
