



Klaus Greinert

Chairman of the Advisory Board of the Röchling Group

Klaus Greinert, born on June 3, 1940 in Berlin, Germany, completed a commercial apprenticeship as a wholesale and foreign trade specialist at Olympia Werke AG. After holding positions at Schering AG, Gillet Roth-Büchner GmbH, Pond's GmbH, and MDV GmbH, he joined the family-owned company Karl Hornung KG, an associated company of Gebr. Röchling, in 1977 as the managing authorized officer. After four years, he moved to Röchling Eisenhandel KG as a personally liable partner. In 1986, he was entrusted with a new area of responsibility at Gebr. Röchling KG and Röchling Industrie Verwaltung GmbH; for eight years he directed various subsidiaries as a general agent and finally, beginning in 1994, as managing partner. In 2000, Klaus Greinert joined the regulatory bodies. In July of the same year, he was appointed Chairman of all the boards. He continues to direct the Advisory Board. Since 1987, Greinert has served as Chairman of the Supervisory Board of Duravit AG, Hornberg, and since 2002, he has also served as the Chairman of the Supervisory Board of Rheinmetall AG.
