



Dr. Andrea Rocca

Dr. Andrea Rocca, born on November 27, 1962 in Turin, Italy, studied mechanical engineering at the Politecnico di Torino University, where he earned his doctorate. Subsequently, he acquired a Master's Degree in plastics material engineering at Kensington University in the US. After his training, he worked from 1983 to 1993 in various positions at his parents' company, an automotive supplier in the plastics industry based in Turin. There, he was laboratory supervisor, director of tool development, director of production and logistics, and finally technical director. In 1994, Rocca became co-owner and Managing Director of the company Autoengineering. At the same time, he worked as a freelancer for the former Seeber Leifers. In 2000, Seeber and Autoengineering formed a joint venture, and Rocca assumed the function of Managing Director of the Competence Center. In 2004, he was appointed Technical Director of Röchling Automotive's Europe South region. He has been a member of Röchling's Management Board since 2008.
