Erwin Doll, born on January 12, 1959 in Rheinbrohl (Rheinland-Pfalz), Germany, graduated as an engineer with a degree (Diplom) in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Kaiserslautern with a specialty in Theoretical Mechanical Engineering.
