Horst-Ulrich Mauß, born on February 23, 1957 in Ellwangen an der Jagst, Baden-Württemberg, Germany, completed two years of service with the German Army in 1979 with the rank of Senior Midshipman of the Reserve. Subsequently, in 1983 Mauß graduated as an industrial engineer with a degree (Diplom) from the University of Applied Sciences in Aalen. During his studies he passed a trade exam as a toolmaker. In the same year, he was promoted to Lieutenant of the Reserve. Mauß started his career as plant manager for plastics processing at the Lapp company in Stuttgart. In 1987, he moved to Elastogran GmbH in Worms as plant manager. With the acquisition of the BASF Elastogran plant in Worms by Röchling, Mauß joined the former Seeber group in 1992. There, he was initially plant manager of Seeber Kunststofftechnik Worms KG before he became Technical Director of Seeber Systemtechnik KG, Worms, in 1993. In September 2005, in addition to his directorship responsibilities, he was appointed to the Executive Board of Röchling Automotive Group and Röchling's Management Board.
