Erwin Doll received a postgraduate degree in theoretical mechanical engineering from the University of Kaiserslautern. Starting in 1984, he subsequently worked for a total of 13 years at BASF in the plastics division, advancing from Project Engineer to Key Account Manager and finally Sales Director. In 1998, Doll joined the automotive supplier Johnson Controls. There, he initially served as Sales Director and later became General Manager of the BMW Group business unit. After four years, Doll joined the Plastic Omnium Group where he assumed duties as a member of the Executive Committee of Plastic Omnium Auto Exterior and Chairman of the Central European region and held the position as Managing Director of Plastic Omnium Group in Germany. In 2006, Doll joined the Röchling Group and was appointed Executive Vice President of Sales and R&D at Röchling Automotive, later in addition also for Asia. In 2011, he was appointed spokesperson of the Röchling Automotive Executive Board.

In June 2016, Doll was appointed to the Executive Board of the Röchling Group and is President & CEO of the Automotive division. Since 2018, Doll is also Vice-chairman of the Röchling Group.
