Gerhard Neidinger studied mechanical engineering at the Trier University of Applied Sciences. His initial career experience came as a design engineer at an R&D company for plastic dies. In 1980, he joined Klöckner Ferromatik Desma GmbH as Export Sales Director. He simultaneously completed a commercial apprenticeship. In 1993, he set up his own company in the area of project planning and sales. Four years later, in 1997, he assumed management responsibilities at the Fair Gruppe Nord before moving to the Röchling Group in 1999. For six years Neidinger served as Managing Director of Sales at Röchling Automotive Leifers. In 2005, he became Technical Managing Director of Röchling Automotive Asia. In subsequent years, he also assumed management responsibilities at Röchling Automotive Parts Changchun, Röchling Automotive Parts Suzhou, and Röchling Automotive Parts Chengdu.

Since 2011, Neidinger has been a member of the Executive Board of Röchling Automotive and is responsible for the activities in Asia.
