In 2000, Seeber and Autoengineering founded a joint venture, and he assumed the role of Managing Director of the Competence Center. In February 2012, he was appointed to the Executive Board of the Röchling Automotive Group and was responsible for the Europe South and America South regions.

Since October 2014, Andrea Rocca is COO and is responsible for Production, Logistics, Quality, Engineering, Project Management and EHS (Environment, Health and Safety) for the Automotive Group.
