



## Rainer Schulz

Rainer Schulz (born 1965) studied production engineering at RWTH Aachen and the Niederrhein University of Technology, for which he was awarded the sponsorship prize of the Association of German Engineers (VDI). He initially held various positions in materials management and production logistics in the electronics and mechanical engineering industries.

From 1995, Rainer Schulz was responsible for global procurement at engine manufacturer BMW Rolls-Royce AeroEngines as production manager and subsequently as overall purchasing manager. As part of the "Procurement Process Excellence" concept, he successfully reengineered the key purchasing processes.

In 2001, he moved to the globally active REHAU Group. As Chief Operating Officer (COO), he was initially responsible for Technology, Productivity and Materials Management within the Executive Board. In 2007/08, he successfully restructured the Automotive business unit. In 2010, Rainer Schulz was appointed Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the REHAU Group.

Since the termination of his operational career at the end of 2018, Rainer Schulz is involved in supervisory boards of various companies and different industries. He is currently on the Board of Directors of Bühler Holding AG (food technology, CH), RUAG International Holding AG (aerospace technology, CH) and Röchling SE & Co. KG. However, the latter membership is dormant during his operational activities on the Executive Board. In addition, as a member of the Board of Directors of EISENMANN SE (Plant Engineering, DE), he accompanied the company through the challenging phase of insolvency.
